Hello Coach,

We would like to **Thank You** very much for volunteering as a coach. Without your involvement this league would not happen. Please express our appreciation to your assistant coaches, parents and sponsors.

Please find attached a schedule for the regular season, a playoff schedule for the end of the season, local rules, pitching logs and maps to the various ball fields.

Rescheduling procedure – if you need to reschedule a game due to knowing at least 24 hours ahead of game time that you will not have at least 8 players, please use the following procedure:

- Notify the other coach and your town rep.
- Host town team - find out from your town rep 2 or 3 dates that a field is available.
- Contact other coach and together decide on a mutually agreeable time to play the game. Do your best to do this ASAP as the closer it gets to the end of the season, the harder it is to make up games. If coaches cannot agree, the two town reps will step in and decide on a time.
- Once a new time is agreed upon, town rep needs to be contacted to schedule an umpire.

Weather cancellation – each town decides independently on weather cancellations and your town representative will notify you. Also, you can check the host town website as there are links to each town and weather cancellations will be listed when possible. If possible try and give a courtesy call to the opposing coach. Rainouts will be made up Friday of the same week.

*All scores need to be sent within 48 hours of the game so they can be listed on the website.

**Score email must include your team name, which you played, score and umpire's name.

Pitching logs – Make sure your roster, dates of birth (and/or league age) are printed on the back of pitching log. You must exchange logs with opposing coach prior to game so you are assured that the other team is pitching younger aged players atleast one inning each game.

Game / Rule Conflicts – Try to resolve the problem on the field with the umpire and the opposing coach. If this is not possible contact you Quadtown Representative listed below and the Quadtown Reps. and the head umpire will resolve the issue and report back to both coaches.
